Greetings from Dean Students' Welfare Office!

23rd March 1931 was a dark day in the history of India; as on this day three heroes of the Indian National Movement – Shri Bhagat Singh, Shri Sukhdev Thapar and Shri Shivaram Rajguru achieved martyrdom as part of their freedom struggle against the repressive colonial rule. To honour and value the supreme sacrifices made by these national icons and to drive out lessons of inspiration from their life and times, our country has been observing 23rd March as the ‘**Shaheed Diwas**’. Their sacrifice still inspires people towards the nation and fills them with the national values. History holds important lessons for the humanity and commemorating such events remind ourselves of the price paid by our ancestors for the freedom we enjoy today.

To commemorate 90 years of martyrdom of our national icons, the University of Delhi will be organizing **Shaheed Diwas** on 23rd March 2021. It is expected that the participants must remain **creative and original** in their ideas, thoughts, presentation and narration. The categories and the pertinent rules for all identified events are mentioned below:

1. Essay writing competition
 - (i) Hindi or English language
 - (ii) Word limit - 500 words
2. Slogan writing competition
 - (i) Hindi or English language
3. Poetry writing competition
 - (i) Hindi or English language
4. Song writing competition (Self composed)
 - (i) Hindi or English language

It is requested that all colleges will wholeheartedly organize the said “**Online**” activities by involving their students. All colleges will send the details* of the winner (1st position holder) in each category to the undersigned by Thursday, 18 March 2021. The University of Delhi will pick best entries out of the pool and these winners will be provided the opportunity to present their work in front of the Chief Guest and the University of Delhi community. The winners shall be provided certificate, memento and a prize whereas all participants shall receive e-certificates.

No entries will be entertained after the deadline i.e., 18 March 2021.
