

Draft Minutes of the Staff Council Meeting held on Friday, 5th October, 2018

A Meeting of the Staff Council was held at 1.00 p.m. on Friday, 5th October, 2018 in the College Library, 75 members attended it; Chairman- in- Council, the Principal Dr. P.K. Sharma, presided. The following issues were deliberated/decided in the meeting:-

- The minutes of the last meeting held on 18-05-2018 were confirmed.
- The Chairman in Council expressed his heartfelt gratitude to the entire Staff for their unconditional support in the marathon Admission process.
- The Report of Building Construction Monitoring & Maintenance cum Infrastructure Committee was presented, in which, the members unanimously recommended and requested the Chair, to have coordination meeting between the College Governing Body and the Bifurcation Committee for expediting the resource sharing process. The Chairman in Council, Dr. Pawan Kumar Sharma shared the due diligence of the Governing Body about the approval of the four-storey New Academic Block Building up to ten storeys. The Staff Council unanimously welcomed the decision of the Governing Body for the extension of the New Academic Block upto 10 storeys. The Principal also placed before the House details of the payments made to the contractor/Architect/Consultant, etc. in respect of the ongoing construction of New Academic Block/SPS Block. He also apprised the House that he is touch with the UGC to get the extension of use of funds sanctioned to the College under OBC expansion. The House unanimously puts on record the appreciation for the efforts taken by the Principal for the completion of the ongoing projects. The House also requested the Principal to take necessary steps in getting the extension of the usage of funds from UGC and take necessary temporary steps for timely release of the payments to the contractor for the smooth completion of the Project. The Staff Council further suggested that funds available with the College in other heads may be used for the payments and same may be recouped once the approval of UGC is received by the College. The Principal expressed his thanks for the support.
- After watching the video of the pre and post state of the dumped and restricted area, the House, unanimously applauded the relentless and thought provoking usage of the waste land into a semi-permanent structure where classes in full-swing were being held for the last two semesters.
- Dr. Archana Anand raised the major issue of opening the college gate towards CGO Complex. Dr. Poonam Gupta suggested that it is mandatory for the separate entity of our New Day College. Mr. Pankaj Jha supported it and said that it would resolve the parking problem.
